## **NOTES**

- INSPECTION: PRIOR TO BACKFILLING, SECURE INSPECTION OF INSTALLATION BY ENGINEER OR DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE.
- BACKFILL: PROVIDE AND PLACE PER DISTRICT STANDARD SECTION 31 05 13. COMPACT PER SECTION 31 23 26 TO A MODIFIED PROCTOR DENSITY OF 95 PERCENT OR GREATER. MAXIMUM LIFT THICKNESS IS 8 INCHES BEFORE COMPACTION.

  A. DO NOT USE SEWER ROCK OR RECYCLED RAP AGGREGATE IN THE PIPE ZONE.

  B. COMPACT BEDUING AROUND PIPE.

- COMPACT BEDDING AROUND FIPE.

  FLOWABLE FILL (ONLY USE AS DIRECTED BY DISTRICT)

  PROVIDE AND PLACE CONTROLLED LOW STRENGTH MATERIAL PER APWA SECTION 31 05 15 IF ALLOWED BY PIPE MANUFACTURER.

  PREVENT PIPE FLOTATION BY INSTALLING IN LIFTS AND PROVIDE PIPE RESTRAINTS AS REQUIRED BY PIPE MANUFACTURER.

  RESET PIPE TO LINE AND GRADE IF PIPE FLOATS OUT OF POSITION.

- 3. PIPE: CULINARY WATER LINE MAINS SHALL BE PVC AND CULINARY SERVICE LATERALS SHALL BE HDPE, AS PER DISTRICT.
- MECHANICAL JOINT CONNECTIONS SHALL INCLUDE "GRIP RING". 4.
- PIPE LOCATION: INSTALL PIPE IN CENTER OF TRENCH OR NO CLOSER THAN 9-IN FROM WALL OF PIPE TO WALL OF TRENCH. HORIZONTAL DISTANCE BETWEEN CULINARY WATER AND SANITARY SEWER SHALL BE AT LEAST 10-FT. VERTICAL DISTANCE SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 18-IN WATER MAINS AND SEWER LINES SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED IN SAME TRENCH.
- PEA GRAVEL: PEA GRAVEL IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY PART OF THE PIPE ZONE.
- FOUNDATION STABILIZATION: USE SEWER ROCK, APWA SECTION 31 05 13. INSTALLATION OF STABILIZATION-SEPARATION GEOTEXTILE PER APWA SECTION 31 05 19 WILL BE REQUIRED TO SEPARATE BACKFILL MATERIAL AND NATIVE SUBGRADE MATERIALS IF SEWER ROCK CANNOT PROVIDE A WORKING SURFACE OR TO PREVENT SOILS MIGRATION.
- CONCRETE COLLAR: CLASS 4000 CONCRETE. JOINTS: PROVIDE A NEAT STRAIGHT JOINT BETWEEN EXISTING AND NEW CONCRETE SURFACE. PROVIDE CONCENTRIC CIRCLE CUT. CLEAN EDGES OF ALL DIRT, OIL AND LOOSE DEBRIS.
